

# contest entry rules

## Contest: 5000 followers on Instagram

1. This contest is held by Auberges de Jeunesse du Saint-Laurent inc. (hereinafter collectively named: "the Contest Organizer"), and it runs from 10:00 AM, Tuesday, April 22, 2025, until 11:59 PM, Tuesday, May 13, 2025 (hereinafter the "Contest Period") on the SAINTLO website ([saintlo.ca](https://saintlo.ca)). The applicable conditions are more fully described herein.

### eligibility

2. This contest is open to residents of Canada, having attained the age of the majority, with the exception of (i) employees and members of the boards of directors of the Contest Organizer.

### how to enter

3. **NO PURCHASE IS REQUIRED.** To be eligible to participate in the contest, you must follow the [@saintlohostels](https://saintlohostels) page, identify the friend with whom you will be taking part in this adventure, and subscribe to the Saintlo newsletter by completing the information requested (hereinafter the "Newsletter Registration Form") by the Contest Organizer in the specific contest publication found on the page <https://saintlo.ca/en/contest-5000followers/> (hereinafter the "Contest Page"). The email address must be the person's usual email address. The answers provided to the newsletter registration form must be truthful. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to cancel any participation that does not comply with these rules.

### newsletter form

4. To enter this contest, entrants must answer the following questions truthfully:
  - a. First name
  - b. Family name
  - c. Email
  - d. Postal code
  - e. The checkbox "I accept to receive information from Saintlo"
    - i. Yes
    - ii. No
  - f. The checkbox "I have read and I accept the rules of the contest"
    - i. Yes
    - ii. No

Once the Newsletter Form is completed, the entrant will be granted one (1) chance to win the prize described hereinafter.

## odds of winning

- The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period. There is no limit to the number of entrants to the contest.

## draw

- The draw for the grand prize will take place at 1:00 PM (EST), Wednesday, May 14, 2025, at the premises of SAINTLO, the holder of the contest: Auberges de Jeunesse du Saint-Laurent inc., 220-5450 Chemin de la Côte des Neiges, Montreal (Québec) H3T 1Y6.
- One (1) winner shall be chosen randomly from all the entrants entered in the contest during the Contest Period. This winner shall be announced (first name and city of the winner) on the Facebook and Instagram pages of the Contest Organizer (found at the following addresses): [facebook.com/saintlohostels](https://facebook.com/saintlohostels) and [instagram.com/saintlo\\_hostels](https://instagram.com/saintlo_hostels) within two (2) days following the draw.

## prize

- The prize offered to the (1) winner is: (2) nights in a private room at the Auberge Internationale de Rivière-du-Loup and rental of (2) bicycles to explore the city, (2) nights in a private room at the Auberge Griffon Aventure and canyoning adventure for (2) people included, (2) nights in a private room at the Auberge Festive le Sea Shack, dinner and drinks at the Cantine Barberousse, as well as a \$250 prepaid card.

The total value of the prize in this contest is approximately **\$1,300**.

- The prize cannot be exchanged for cash, but it may be modified according to the conditions in Article 19 of these rules. Any other expenses related to the acceptance of the prize shall be at the cost of the winner. The prize will be sent by email to the winner of the contest.



## awarding of the prize

10. To be declared winner and claim their prize, the entrant whose entry was randomly drawn must satisfy the following conditions:
  - a. Respect the conditions of eligibility of the contest described in these rules, particularly as to reaching the age of majority, the country of residence and the use of a real, usual email address.
  - b. Be reached by email by the Contest Organizer, and respond to the email sent to this effect, within three (3) business days following the date to which the entrant is contacted by the Contest Organizer.
  - c. If it is impossible to reach the entrant selected by private message or by email in the three (3) business days following the date of the announcement of the winner, they will no longer have a right to the prize and the Contest Organizer may reward the prize to another entrant whose name was drawn.
  - d. Sign the declaration and liability waiver that will be sent by email and returned to the organizers of the contest in response to the email received, within seven (7) days following the send date.

If the entrant whose entry form was randomly drawn does not respect the conditions mentioned above or any condition set out in these rules, they shall be disqualified and a new draw shall be carried out until a winner is determined.

11. On reception of their duly signed declaration and liability waiver, the winner shall be informed of the way that they may receive their prize.

## personal information

12. By entering this contest, all entrants consent to the collection, the use and the divulgation of their personal information by the Contest Organizer and their partners with the goal of administering this contest and awarding the prize. 13. The entrants consent to the use of their name, address (city, province), voice, statements, images, photos or other representations and recordings, on all media and on all supports, including but not limited to the Internet for publicity and promotional purposes and without notice or remuneration, and may be required to sign a document to this effect. The personal information of the entrants shall not be otherwise used or divulged without their respective written consent.

## general regulations

14. None of the partners, sponsors, affiliates and franchisees of the Contest Organizer, and their employees, (hereinafter the "Group") may be held responsible for the use of the prize awarded as part of this contest, nor do they assume any responsibility for the prize or the events that may arise from the contest, subject however to the limits laid out in the applicable legislation. The winner shall sign a waiver to this effect, which must comply with what is described above.
15. The entry forms shall be subject to verification by the Contest Organizer, as the case may be, particularly in order to establish that these rules are respected. Any entry sent after the Contest Period, obtained from an unauthorized source or that does not respect these rules will not give the right to an eligible entry. Any person who enters or tries to enter this contest using a means contrary to the spirit of this contest and of a nature as to be unfair to the other entrants (e.g: hacking, sending multiple entries, etc.) shall be automatically disqualified and may be reported to the relevant legal authorities. The decision of the Contest Organizers to this effect is final.
16. The Contest Organizer and the members of the Group assume no responsibility for entry forms that are received after the Contest Period, lost, stolen, incorrectly sent, incomplete, fraudulent, modified, destroyed, and any such forms shall be refused. The Contest Organizer and the members of the Group assume no responsibility for any problem, breakdown, poor technical functioning of a network line, online computer system, telephone, software program, server, supplier, email, browser, platform or site, particularly the Contest Page contest or more generally, the website Saintlo.ca, or poor technical functioning that may occur, including but not limited to, a problem with the transmission or non-transmission of an entry form, for any cause whatsoever, or for any problem making it impossible to view online the prize offered to the winner. The Contest Organizer and the members of the Group are not responsible for erroneous or incorrect information, whether it is caused by users or by the equipment and/or software programs associated with or used by the contest or by a technical or human error that may occur during the holding of the contest, including during processing of the entry forms. The Contest Organizer and the members of the Group are not responsible for any injuries or damage that may result from the holding of the contest. All entry forms become the property of the Contest Organizer and shall not be returned to the entrants. The Contest Organizer reserves the right to destroy all documents related to the contest once the required legal holding period has expired.
17. The entrant recognizes that the execution of the services related to the prize is the complete and sole responsibility of the suppliers of services. The winner must sign a clause to this effect, included in the declaration and liability waiver. Finally, the entrant recognizes that in the case where they are named winner, they shall be completely and solely responsible for ensuring that they shall be able to receive their prize, particularly with regard to their availability during the scheduled times, etc.

The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at their complete discretion, to substitute a prize of the same nature or equal value in the case where the prize or an element of this prize may not be available for any reason whatsoever. Subject to the foregoing, the prize must be accepted as awarded and may not be exchanged for money or any other product.

19. The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at their complete discretion, to cancel, terminate or suspend this contest should a virus, a computer bug, an unauthorized human intervention or any other situation beyond their control arise that could undermine or affect the administration, security, impartiality or execution of this Contest as provided for in these Rules, subject to authorization by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec.
20. From the time the prize was awarded to the winner, the Contest Organizer, and their representatives, shall not be responsible in any way for situations where the prize was acquired, such as: stoppage or suspension of trains, closing of the establishment, change(s) of owners(s) or manager(s), cancelation or postponement of the festival, a work conflict or any other situations that may directly or indirectly affect the prize of the winner.
21. This contest is subject to all applicable laws and federal, provincial and municipal regulations. The decisions of the Contest Organizer are final regarding all aspects of the contest, subject to the applicable legislation.
22. For the purposes of this contest, the entrant is the person whose personal email address, name, and information sent in the Questionnaire were used for the entry. It's this person who shall be awarded the prize in the event that their entry is chosen during the draw. By entering the contest, the entrant recognizes that they have read and understood these rules and accepted to be bound by them and comply with them. 23. Any dispute regarding the organization or conduct of this contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec for a ruling. Any dispute regarding the awarding of the prize may be submitted to the Régie for the sole purpose of attempting to reach a settlement.
24. Decease: in the event of the death of the winner before the draw, their participation will be automatically canceled and the prize will be forfeited. For practical logistical purposes, not knowing the legal heirs, the Contest Organizer may, at their convenience, rehold a draw to determine a new winner.
